

Yellow circuit - The Lot valley and Cahors (86 km / 54 miles)

We hope these directions are helpful, but please note that they are intended to be used strictly in conjunction with a sufficiently detailed map. Feedback welcome of course!

Go from Cubertou to Duravel and the D911 -

- Either taking the *shortest* route : Turn right out of Cubertou drive and immediately first right towards Duravel. Wind your way through the woods, until you emerge at a T-junction, where you turn right and drop steeply down a narrow road into Duravel. In Duravel, turn left at the roundabout next to the (excellent) Office de Tourisme onto the D911.
- Or if that sounds too risky : Turn left out of Cubertou drive and go straight on to Condat. At the T-junction in Condat turn left. After a short distance, turn left and keep straight on as far as Duravel. In Duravel, go straight on at the roundabout next to the (excellent) Office de Tourisme. You are on the D911.

Follow the D911 (shown as D811 on older maps) through Puy l'Evêque and Prayssac, past Mercuès castle high on the cliffs dominating the Lot valley, as far as Cahors. Follow signs to *Centre ville*. Allow at least half a day to enjoy the city, and don't complicate life - return by the same route!
